



NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPLY FOR U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FUNDING

The City of Suffolk hereby provides notice of intent to apply for a U. S. Department of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance. The City of Suffolk is requesting \$73,767 in JAG funding to purchase equipment and overtime for special assignments for the Police Department and training and supplies for the Commonwealth's Attorney Office.

A draft copy of the application is being prepared and will be available for public review and comment in the Suffolk Police Department at 120 Henley Place. The deadline for submission of the grant application is July 9, 2009. Comments on the proposed JAG application will be accepted until Monday, July 2, 2009.
