City Offices Closed in Observance of Labor Day

SUFFOLK, VA (August 30, 2010) In observance of Labor Day, Suffolk City offices will be closed Monday, September 6, 2010. Normal operations will resume Tuesday, September 7, at 8:30 a.m. The city observes all state-designated holidays. Labor Day is considered a holiday for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

All **Suffolk City libraries** will be closed Monday, September 6, and will reopen on Tuesday, September 7, at 9 a.m. The **Suffolk Museum** will be closed Monday, September 6, and will reopen on Tuesday, September 7, at 10 a.m. The City's **Tourism Visitor Center** will remain open on Monday, September 6.

Suffolk's four major parks – Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, and Bennett's Creek will remain open during the holiday; however, no park attendant will be on duty.

Due to the City's new four-day pick-up schedule (effective July 4, 2010), there will **not** be any changes in scheduled routes. A reminder that trash must be placed at curbside no later than 7 a.m. on the **regular** scheduled **collection day**.
