SUFFOLK, Virginia (August 24, 2010) The cargo of the super load move traveling through Suffolk this evening is a submarine propeller, and the travel time they are scheduled to enter Suffolk on US58 has been revised to between the hours of 11:00 pm and midnight.

POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVE TONIGHT

SUFFOLK, Virginia (August 24, 2010) If you are traveling on eastbound US58 between 9:00 this evening and 5:30 tomorrow morning, the Department of Public Works would like to make you aware of a super load move that could possibly cause a delay in traffic. A load measuring over 18 feet wide and 86 feet long is scheduled to enter Suffolk on US58 from Southampton County and continue eastbound through Suffolk to Chesapeake.
