Fire Marshal Investigators Seek Information on Explosive Device

SUFFOLK, VA (October 26, 2010) On October 25th just before 6:30 p.m., police and fire units were dispatched to the 4400 block of Cherokee Drive for an explosive device discovered in a wooded area by a resident. Fire Marshals responded and discovered an improvised explosive device that had not functioned. An agent with the Virginia State Police Explosive Ordnance Disposal Unit responded to the scene and secured the device.

The incident is under investigation by the Suffolk Fire Marshal's Office. Anyone with information is asked to call 514-4540, or Crime Line at 1-888-Lock-U-Up. When calling Crime Line, callers do not have to give their names or appear in court. If a caller's information leads to an arrest, the caller could qualify for a reward of up to \$1,000.
